DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

In order to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), a student entering Grade 9 must earn:

- ✓ **30** credits (18 compulsory credits and 12 optional credits),
- ✓ complete **40** hours of community involvement,
- ✓ and pass the secondary school literacy test.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA

COMPULSORY CREDITS (TOTAL OF **18**)

4 credits	in English (1 credit per grade)
1 credit	in French as a second language
3 credits	in Mathematics (at least 1 credit in grade 11 or 12)
2 credits	in Science
1 credit	in Canadian History
1 credit	in Canadian Geography
1 credit	in the Arts
1 credit	in Health and Physical Education
.5 credit	in Civics (grade 10)
.5 credit	in Career Studies (grade 10)

PLUS:

1 additional Group 1 credit	in English, or French as a second language, or a Native Language, or a classical or an international language, or Social Sciences and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance and Career Education, or cooperative education**
1 additional Group 2 credit	in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or cooperative education**
1 additional Group 3 credit	in Science (grade 11 or 12), or Technological Education (grade 9-12), or cooperative education**

**a maximum of 2 credits in cooperative education can count as compulsory credits
