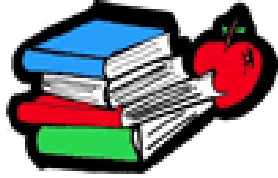


STUDENT SUCCESS INITIATIVE

Student Success was an initiative started in schools across Ontario in 2005 by the Ministry of Education with the focus on designing and implementing innovative programs aimed at helping all students achieve their potential and succeed in secondary school. South Lincoln staff are proud to support this program and its fundamental aim at helping student’s succeed. The purpose of the program is to reduce the drop-out rate by keeping young people in school, increase graduation rates and encourage youth who have recently left school to return and complete diploma requirements.

Our At-Risk students are comprised of students who have a history of irregular attendance and/or low credit accumulation, as well as students who require some social or emotional support. Teacher mentors are assigned to students to advocate for students who need varied supports and interventions in order to succeed.

As part of this initiative, the Student Success Program at South Lincoln will focus on areas such as:

- ▶ credit recovery
- ▶ alternative education
- ▶ student success in Grades 9 and 10
- ▶ program pathways to apprenticeship and the workplace
- ▶ college connections
- ▶ success for targeted groups of students
